



## Associate of Arts in Liberal Arts Pathway to **CHW Plus** Requirements

The Community Health Worker (CHW) Plus pathway combines the liberal arts core with the CHW pathway plus coursework in human services, sociology, and psychology. The following are the course options for the CHW Plus pathway.

Eighteen or 19 credit hours must be earned through the completion of the required courses and electives. Additional requirements: an overall GPA of 2.0 or above in all CHW courses is required, a cumulative GPA of 2.0 for all pathway courses, and the completion of a PSY 101 course within the general “core” education requirements.
