



Associate of Arts in Liberal Arts Medical Assisting Certificate Program Requirements

A total of 60 semester credit hours are required for the Associate of Arts in Liberal Arts: 44 credit hours of core and elective requirements at Chatfield College and 16 core medical assisting requirements at The Christ College of Nursing and Health Sciences. Students who complete the program requirements will earn their Medical Assisting Certificate.

A student must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA overall and for all pathway courses to be awarded the Associate of Arts in Liberal Arts with a pathway to medical assisting.
